

PORTS AMERICA OAKLAND OPERATING RULES

- **NO SPEEDING! 10 M.P.H. is the speed limit.**
- **Drivers are not allowed to plug or unplug reefers on terminal. Violators will be banned.**
- **All persons entering or leaving are subject to search.**
- **Seat Belts and P.P.E. are mandatory.**
- **All drivers must have in their possession a TWIC card, valid driver's license, vehicle registration and proof of insurance ready for examination by security personnel. No admission without proper I.D.**
- **All yard equipment has the right of way.**
- **Stop at all stop signs.**
- **Over Dimensional Containers MUST use Lane 1 for terminal entrance**
- **Remain in designated aisle-ways; do not cut between container rows.**
- **Do not enter or cross out-bound queuing lanes in order to gain access to the Terminal.**
- **Watch for pedestrian traffic.**
- **Lower chassis legs prior to parking containers.**
- **Raise chassis legs prior to picking up containers.**
- **Remain in your vehicle at all times unless it is operationally necessary to leave it.**
- **Cell phone use while operating equipment is prohibited.**
- **Do not park or leave vehicles in unauthorized areas.**
- **No pets or children are allowed on the facility.**
- **Export Reefers MUST go to Genset area for Temp Check**

- ***IN THE EVENT OF AN EVACUATION, PROCEED TO OUTGATE AND PROVIDE NAME AND TRUCKING COMPANY TO SECURITY PERSONNEL***

Failure to follow these instructions or those of security personnel will result in a driver being fined and/or banned from the terminal.
